September:

Following government advice, we have completed our risk assessment for September. We plan to bring all students in full time, with our usual day 8:40-2:15.

We will operate as 3 'bubbles'; Amethyst and Sapphire; Topaz, Pearl, Jasper and Opal; Aquamarine, Ruby and Emerald. There will be limited movement of staff between the bubbles. We will continue with the high standards of hygiene currently in place. We have issued our 'bubbles' to transport, who are making arrangements to keep the students in their consistent bubbles. This may require some "double drop offs", so we are having a flexible 8:40-9:00am start and 2:00-2:15pm finish. Transport will be in touch with individual families if your arrangements are affected. We will continue to offer packed lunches only, with the addition of salads and baked potatoes. This arrangement will be reviewed in September. If you are not entitled to free school meals, please send your child with an appropriate packed lunch, or you can purchase one from school for £2.05 for primary students and £2.20 for secondary students. If your circumstances have changed and you believe you are now entitled to free school meals please submit an application directly to Stockton Borough Council either by phone (01642 526605) or via their website: (www.stockton.gov.uk/fsm).

Some parents have discussed concerns about their child returning. We are happy to work with families to help all students return safely, and will support part timetables where necessary. If you have any concerns, please discuss with a member of staff.

SCHOOL UNIFORM


